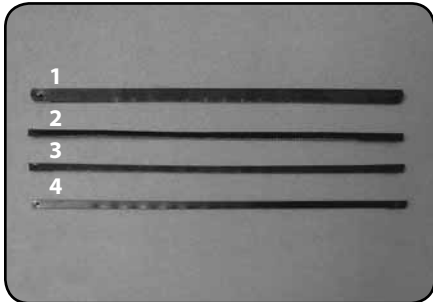

1 Blade Installation



1. Hold the blade holder (wing nut) in place and loosen the saw handle.
2. Install the desired blade into the blade holder at each end of the saw.

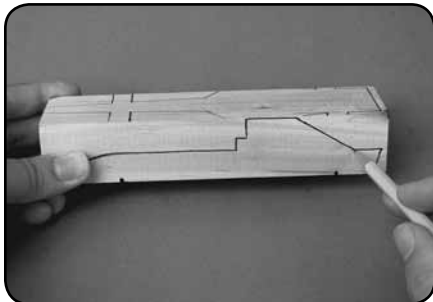


Blade Descriptions:

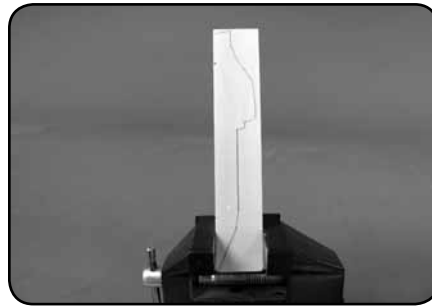
1. Hacksaw Blade
Metal
2. Extra Fine Blade
Metal / Wood
3. Fine Blade
Metal / Wood
4. Medium Blade
Wood

3. Hold the blade holder (wing nut) and tighten the saw handle until the saw blade is secure.

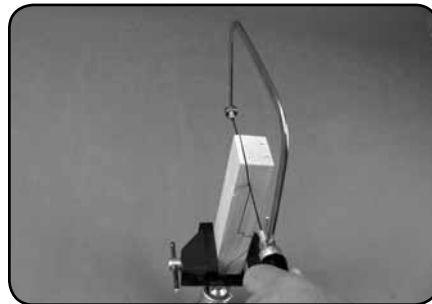
2 Cutting the Basic Shape



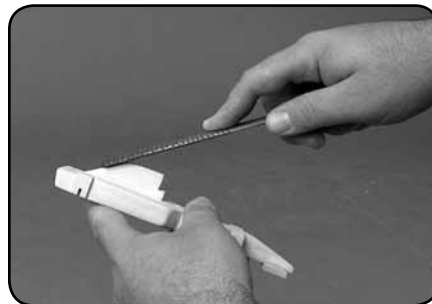
1. Draw your desired design on the wooden block.



2. Place your block into a vise to securely hold it while cutting and shaping.



3. Cut the shape of the racer.



4. Use the rasp to shape your racer. Start with the coarse teeth and then the fine teeth.

5. Smooth your racer with sandpaper to the desired finish.
